

知 Can the Bootrom File and the Software Version File Be Deleted upon Successful Upgrade of the S9500 Series?

After Bootrom of a board is successfully upgraded, the Bootrom is written into the Bootrom chip. Once the board is started later, Bootrom file information will be read out from the Bootrom chip, so Bootrom file information can be removed from the Flash. The software version file consists of two parts, i.e., the SRPU part and the LPU part. This file is invoked each time the SRPU and the LPU are started, so it cannot be deleted.
