

知 Is S9500 Policy Routing Strong Policy Routing or Weak Policy Routing

Strong policy routing means that the packets are dropped if the next hop address does not exist after the stream is redirected to the next hop address.

Weak policy routing means that after the stream is redirected to the next hop address, the packets are processed according to the destination IP address rather than redirected and dropped.

S9500 versions before 1325 support only strong policy routing, and versions after 1325 can be configured to support strong or weak policy routing, with strong policy routing as the default configuration.
